



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FOR TEACHING AND LEARNING (T&L) DURING TRANSITION TO ENDEMIC PHASE FOR SEMESTER II SESSION 2021/22

1. What is the mode of Teaching and Learning for this semester?

As the country enters the Transition to Endemic Phase on **1st April 2022**, the Teaching and Learning mode for this semester needs to be amended in accordance with the Government decision.

As such, the Teaching and Learning mode for this semester will be amended as stated in the [Academic Circular No 2/22](#).

2. How will the Teaching and Learning activities be carried out during the Transition to Endemic Phase for this semester?

(a) For the first part of the semester **20th March 2022 – 28th April 2022 (UTM JB)** and **21st – 29th April 2022 (UTM KL)**, all Teaching and Learning activities will be carried out as stipulated in the [Academic Circular No 1/22](#).

(b) For the second part of the semester **8th May 2022 – 30th June 2022 (UTM JB)** and **9th May 2022 – 1st July 2022 (UTM KL)**, all Teaching and Learning activities will be carried out via physical and face-to-face or in a blended learning mode.

However, there will be **fully online** classes should there be any unavoidable constraints.

Students are required to check with their respective School on the mode of delivery for their courses or through UTM ACAD system at <http://academic.utm.my> under the 'Learning Method' menu beginning 16th April 2022.

3. What does the blended learning mode mean for this semester?

It means that the Teaching and Learning activities are a combination of fully online learning and physical face-to-face delivery mode.

If your School decides to conduct Teaching and Learning in a blended mode, then the schedule for both online and physical classes will be made available to you.

4. How do I know the mode of T&L for my course this semester?

You can check the mode of delivery for your course in the **UTM ACAD system** (<http://academic.utm.my>) in the 'Learning Method' menu beginning 16th April 2022.

5. I am an international student, and I cannot return to campus before 8/9 May 2022. What should I do?

You must inform your respective lecturers immediately and explain your constraints.

6. I have unavoidable constraints that limits me from returning to campus before 8/9 May 2022. Can I attend my classes online?

You must refer to your respective course lecturers about the mode of delivery for your courses. It will also be available in the **UTM ACAD system** (<http://academic.utm.my>) by 16th April 2022. If the mode is online, then you can attend your classes online.

7. The mode of delivery for one of my courses is 'blended learning' but I have unavoidable constraints and cannot come back to campus this semester before 8/9 May. Can I attend my classes online?

Students are encouraged to be on campus as early as possible. However, if you cannot come back to campus for the physical and face-to-face session, please contact your School to inform them about your situation.

- 8. The mode of delivery for one of my courses is 'Face-to-Face' but I have unavoidable constraints and cannot come back to campus this semester. Can I attend my classes online?**

Please contact your School to inform them about your situation.

- 9. I am an international student and I want to return to campus, but I cannot make it by 8/9 May 2022 due to visa issues/accommodation arrangements. Can I come back later?**

International students are encouraged to be on campus as early as possible. However, if your courses are carried out in a blended mode, then you should contact your School on the arranged schedule.

- 10. I am a postgraduate research student; will my viva voce be conducted face to face?**

No, viva voce will continue to be conducted online.
